Any monetary offerings included in the envelopes will be used for Masses for the Faithful Departed.

Praying for Our Beloved Dead

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to Holy Souls with the usual conditions once per day from Nov 1-8. All who have gone to Confession, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's Intentions, can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church and there reciting an Our Father and the Apostles' Creed. Confession may be made at any time with the week preceding or the week following Nov 1st.

• **Six reliquaries** are now displayed in the side chapels for veneration. Many thanks to our Altar Society for the donation of these beautiful new reliquaries!

• **Our Lady Help of Persecuted Christians.** This is the 18th Marian Prayer Program sponsored by the Knights of Columbus. The icon will be displayed until Nov 14. This "pays particular attention to the suffering of today's Christians in the Middle East and features the icon of Our Lady Help of Persecuted Christians."
