NOVEMBER IS THE MONTH OF ALL SOULS

• Those who wish their beloved deceased to be remembered at Masses during the month of November should write the names on the special envelopes (from the packet) which will be kept on the altar during November. Any monetary offerings included in the envelopes will be used for Masses for the Faithful Departed.

• **Praying for Our Beloved Dead**
The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to Holy Souls with the usual conditions once per day from Nov 1-8. All who have gone to Confession, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's Intentions, can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church and there reciting an Our Father and the Apostles' Creed. Confession may be made at any time with the week preceding or the week following Nov 1st.



• **Six reliquaries** are now displayed in the side chapels for veneration. The relics are of St. Jude Thaddeus (the Apostle), St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, St. Pius X, St. Philip Neri, St. Gregory the Great, the True Cross, and the Holy Crib.
