Parish Giving & Income November & December 2019
Our budget requires our weekly collection to be \$22,100. For the month of November's four Sundays, that adds up to \$88,400. We gave/collected \$88,556 which is \$156 OVER our goal! For December's five Sundays, we needed to collect \$110,500. We gave/collected \$120,232 which is \$9732 OVER our goal! Blessing of Saint Blaise

From Aletheia.org: *It's an ancient custom of the Church to bless the sick, rooted in the ministry of Christ and his apostles. The annual blessing of throats is a traditional sign of the struggle against illness in the life of the Christian. The blessing is ordinarily given on Feb 3, the memorial of St. Blaise, following Candlemas, the feast of the Presentation of the Lord. The blessing of Saint Blaise—the blessing of throats—will be offered at the end of Masses THIS weekend.*
