ASH WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 26 LENT BEGINS

Ash Wednesday Masses are at 6:30 and 8:15am and 5:30pm.

LENT: Fasting & Abstinence

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and on each Friday of Lent. This obligation prohibits the eating of meat (and meat broth, bacon bits, etc.).

Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal on a given fast day. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength, but they should not, if put together, equal one full meal. Also, eating solid foods or caloric beverages between meals (snacking) is not permitted. **Catholics ages 18 to 59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.**

Sickness, hard manual labor, pregnancy, nursing, etc., automatically excuse a person from these obligations but please remember: these are serious obligations. If in doubt or if you have questions, please speak with a priest.

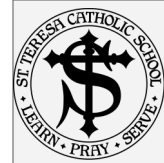
