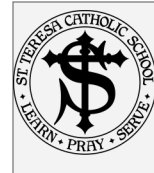

Construction Updates

For the first time in its 70-year history, the school's gymnasium has air conditioning! The cafeteria—after 90 years in use—also has air conditioning. The remainder of the school's air conditioning should be functioning by early next week.

Additionally, the school's solar panels produced 4,743 KWh of electricity—enough to power 4.5 homes for a month!

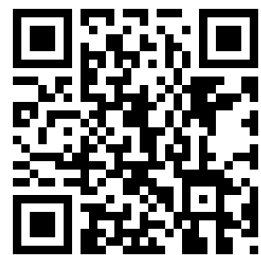

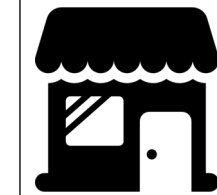
Members of St. Teresa Parish: Altar Society or Men's Club will pay for half of the cost of a standard retreat once per retreat-year!
