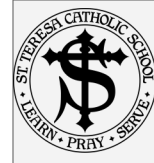

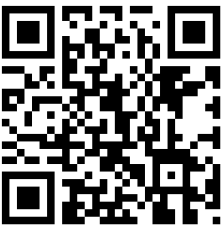
**Good Friday Collection**
