Mass will take place in church, along with the rosary in many languages. Following the rosary, we will process outside and around the city block of the church with candles. The Blessed Mother asked for "many prayers" to offset the evils of 1917 and for future generations. Let us gather as one to pray for an end to Coronavirus, civil unrest in our country, and for God's hand upon the upcoming elections.

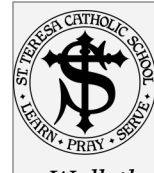
### Grand Group
