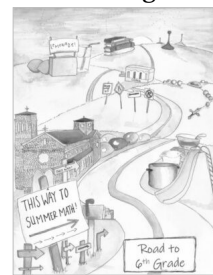

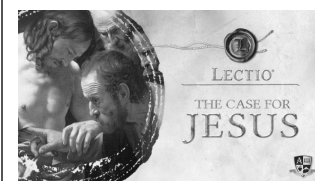
Join us for a 4-week parish study led by Fr. Hottovy on Lectio: The Case for Jesus.
