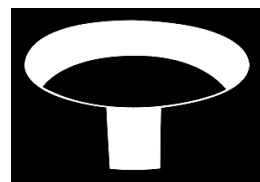

## Altar Servers

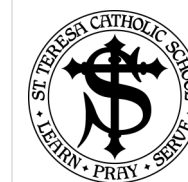
We are working toward organizing, scheduling, and retraining our Altar Servers. Thank you for your patience! There is not currently a schedule but one is in the works.
