PRODIGAL Prayer Partners

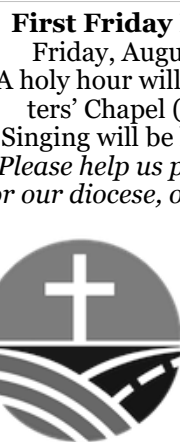
Many of us have been praying for our loved ones: friends, relatives, or even our own children who are no longer practicing the Faith. Our prayers become more powerful when prayed with others.

EXCITING SCRIP UPDATES!

Starting in April, 60% of rebates earned by school families become tuition credits. Many of you should have seen those credits on the tuition statements you received earlier this month! In the inaugural two months of this new program, 29 school families earned tuition credits totaling over \$960! The highest earning family received a credit over \$100, for just those 2 months. Annually, that one family could reduce their tuition payment by more than \$600. The Scrip program is also contributing nearly \$1300 to the ThriveNOW fund. CCD Coordinator

Frequency: Start-up at beginning of school year, then as needed.
The CCD Coordinator will make the calendar for the CCD school year, will make sure that we have teachers for each section, and will help plan events and services for the students. S/he will communicate between parents and teachers.

3rd and 4th Grade CCD Teacher

Frequency: Every Wednesday 4:00-5:15pm
